Green Mountain United Way accepts, and greatly appreciates, computer donations. Computers must be in decent condition and have three years or less of use.

Green Mountain United Way prefers to distribute large quantities of items through its non-profit network, but often times, Green Mountain United Way is able to connect donors directly to recipients.

Green Mountain United Way does not have office space to store office furniture, copiers or other large-sized items. However, these items are often of great need, and through the network, partners can be informed of the donation and pick-up/drop-off times can be coordinated.
